PALM DESERT/INDIAN WELLS, CA – (May 3, 2022) – *Palm Desert Brew at the Zoo* returns to The Living Desert Zoo and Gardens on Saturday, May 7 with a wide array of local and regional craft beers and bites, including selections from <u>La Quinta Brewing Company</u>, <u>Coachella Valley Brewing Company</u>, <u>Golden State Cider</u> and <u>Golden Road Brewing</u>.

Guests will also be able to explore the <u>Rhino Savanna</u> boardwalk and African Safari trail, catch a glimpse of giraffe, cheetah, and rhino, take in the sunset, play games and more. The evening will be complemented with live entertainment by Lisa Lynn and the Broken Hallelujahs, The Refills, and DJ Modgirl.
