Welcome Dogs and Dog Parents!

Where to Wander with Your Pup

Dogs are welcome in most areas of the Zoo, with a few important exceptions. Please be respectful of posted guidelines to ensure a safe and enjoyable visit for all.

Dogs are restricted from certain areas for guests and animal safety.

- Walk through aviaries
- Restaurants (indoors)
- Giraffe feeding platform
- Australian Adventures
- Goat Kraal
- Wildlife Hospital viewing area
- Nature trails
- Oasis Splash Pad
- Mission: Pollination! Pollinator Playground

Please note: Service animals are permitted in some of these areas, where appropriate.



Creature Comforts

Keep your pup happy and hydrated with water bowls located throughout the Zoo (*see map for locations*). Your furry friend is also invited to splash and play in the Paws & Splash Zone, located just outside the main splash pad.

For everyone's enjoyment, please use trash receptacles to dispose of waste. A convenient animal relief area with bags and a trash can is located near the Nature Trail gates, just past the Bee Garden.

Pack Leader Protocol

If your dog is excessively panting, barking, or shaking, they might need a break. The best way to stop a dog from barking is to redirect by walking another direction.

If Zoo animals appear aggressive or agitated because of a dog's presence or behavior, please move on with your walk.



Keep it Paw-sitive

We strive to provide a safe and paw-sitive experience for all. When visiting with your canine companion, you agree to the following:

- My dog will be under my control at all times.
- My dog has an up-to-date rabies vaccination.
- My dog will be on a non-retractable, no more than six feet leash at all times. Dogs in carriers or strollers must also be attached on a leash.
- My dog and I will stay on Zoo's main paths at all times and refrain from entering restricted areas.
- I will clean up after my dog and ensure it gets proper hydration.
- I will not allow my dog to have contact with any Zoo animal, or act in a way that agitates Zoo animals or other guests/dogs.
- I understand that if I am asked to leave for not following these requirements, I am not eligible for a refund.

Guests who are unable to keep their dogs under calm control or need to be addressed by a Living Desert Team Member repeatedly may be asked to leave the Zoo without a refund.
